This year's contest date was originally scheduled for *Friday, May 1, 2015*. This now becomes the deadline date for *poetry/prose & artistic* entries.

The Executive Committee decided on a format that continues to honour tradition and embraces change. With this commitment, we hope to encompass a greater spectrum of student strengths. Students have the option of preparing an artistic piece or writing a piece of poetry or prose. Should your school participate, please note that all registrations must be faxed in to the numbers listed on the registration forms <u>no later than</u> <u>April 21st</u>, <u>2015</u>.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The letter to the student informs them and you of the Criteria for the Contest. The student may enter <u>one</u> of the following contests:

Option 1 POETRY/PROSE (The final GOOD copy must be faxed or emailed in to Mr. Aulino @ Father Bressani or Mrs. Polin-De Luca @ Philip Pocock at least one week prior to facilitate evaluation-no later than <u>April 24th, 2015</u>)
Option 2 ARTISTIC EXPRESSION (Written Component must be emailed prior to delivery of item. There should also be a copy with the actual physical item that <u>must</u> be delivered either to Father Bressani in Woodbridge or Philip Pocock in Mississauga no later than <u>May 1st, 2015</u>)

They must choose <u>one</u> theme from the topics listed below:

IMPORTANT : All students must identify their grade level as well as the category they fit into. (Please see enclosure). It is necessary to understand that they must be entered in the correct category. If the OATI executive is made aware that the student has knowingly been entered in the wrong category and wins a prize, they will be <u>automatically disqualified</u>. OATI entry forms must be submitted for all categories by <u>April 21st</u>, 2015.

The participation fee is **\$7.00 per student** with a **\$35.00 school fee**. All cheques must be made payable to OATI (or The Ontario Association of Teachers of Italian).

We are very enthusiastic about this year's contest. Notwithstanding changes noted above, the OATI will uphold the traditions and foster the continued success of last year's contest. 
Students of Italian:

Please be advised that there are only two options for the contest; a poetry/prose option, and an open artistic option. Students in Grades 10 – 12 are invited to participate. OPTION 1: You may choose to express the theme via written piece of prose or poetry. The final must be faxed in or emailed by <u>May 1, 2015</u> to Mr. Aulino @ Father Bressani in Woodbridge or Mrs. Polin-De Luca @ Philip Pocock in Mississauga. The teacher must verify via email or phone that the entry has been received by the committee.

OPTION 2: An artistic piece; sculpture, collage, painting, etc. accompanied by a description in Italian of no more than 100-150 words must accompany the piece. This item should find its way to either Mr. Aulino @ Father Bressani in Woodbridge or Mrs. Polin-De Luca @ Philip Pocock in Mississauga. The teacher must verify via email or phone that the entry has been received by the committee.

- \Rightarrow The criteria for evaluation are:
 - relevance to theme
 - ♥ creativity
 - ♦ clarity of oral description



CATEGORIES:

- You are in CATEGORY A if you have no exposure to Italian language outside of the classroom.
- You are in CATEGORY A2 if you have no exposure to Italian language whatsoever
- You are in **CATEGORY B** if you have had some exposure to Italian language outside of the classroom, but have not been in Italy for more than three consecutive months in the last three years.
- You are in CATEGORY B2 if you have no exposure to Italian language whatsoever
- You are in **CATEGORY C** if you have regular exposure to Italian language outside of the classroom and/or have spent at least three consecutive months in Italy in the last three years.
